Joy Giving 2011-2012

Joy Giving is a faith-based program with special emphasis upon a sacrificial offering for "others". Accepting this challenge not only demonstrates your love for others, but you will also enable us to move forward in bringing about financial stability to our local church.

- 1) Your promise is by FAITH. As the Lord challenges you and supplies your needs, you will give in this special offering to others.
- 2) JOY is simply the spiritual discipline to put "Jesus" first, "Others" second, and "You" last in your giving. That is the reason we consider this a sacrificial offering.
- 3) You can consider all previous promise (pledge) commitments fulfilled when you commit to JOY Giving.
- 4) JOY PROMISES are intended to be an amount above and beyond your normal 10% tithe. It is important to designate on your check and/or offering envelope one amount for your tithe and another for JOY Giving.
- 5) The promise term is November 1, 2011 through October 31, 2012.
- 6) Funds received for JOY Giving will be used for "Funding the Mission" needs. This includes our General Fund (WEF and some 10% giving), Pensions and Benevolence Fund, Educational (TNU) Fund, and United District Fund.
- 7) Traditional Thanksgiving and Easter offerings will continue to be received to give opportunity for additional giving to "Fund the Mission." Some 10% Mission Specials such as Alabaster also will continue to be received.
